CASCADE COUNTY SOLID WASTE DISTRICT POLICY & PROCEDURE

PURPOSE

The purpose of this document is to define the rules and operational policies for container sites within Cascade County.

SCOPE & APPLICABILITY

This policy is applicable to all Cascade County Solid Waste District employees and citizens of Cascade County who utilize the container sites.

CONTAINER SITE RULES & OPERATIONAL POLICIES

- Sites are for the use of residential household waste only.
- No commercial or industrial wastes are accepted at container sites.
- Tires, furniture, mattresses, oversize wood products, stumps, oil, truck toppers or any other oversized waste is prohibited at the container site.
- Residential wastes that are large or oversized and that do not fit in the containers must be hauled directly to the landfill. Extremely heavy wastes, such as broken concrete or asphalt shingles, produced by a citizen must be hauled directly to the landfill.
- Toilets, sinks, microwaves, plastic tub dishwashers and televisions that meet the 40-inch requirement are allowed in the containers.
- Metal recycling area is for appliances and metals only.
- All hazardous wastes are prohibited at the sites.
- All acceptable wastes must be placed in the containers. Placing it on or near a container or throwing waste on the ground is littering. This is a punishable crime.
- Salvaging or scavenging of any material at any time is prohibited.
- All recycling services at the container sites are for residential use only (no commercial/business use).
- Explosives or firearm ammunition is prohibited at all container sites.
- Removing metals or dismantling appliances in the recycle area by citizens is prohibited and subject to prosecution.
- All materials or waste disposed at the container sites becomes the property of the Cascade County Solid Waste District.
- Indecent exposure or urinating on or around containers or anywhere on the premises is prohibited and subject to prosecution.

- Items such as doors, pallets, small quantities of lumber, plywood or drywall that meet the 40" X 40" maximum dimension requirement can go in the containers.
- VERBAL ABUSE: USING THREATENING, PROFANE OR ABUSIVE LANGUAGE IS A VIOLATION OF MONTANA CODE ANNOTATED 45-8-101. DISORDERLY CONDUCT: A VIOLATION PUMISHABLE BY FINE AND/OR IMPRISONMENT IN THE COUNTY JAIL.
